We aim to provide a balance between the development of artistic skills using a step by step approach and the exploration and experimentation required to be creative. Pupils will be taught how to handle the tools required for a variety of arts and crafts and how to use a variety of media. They will also be exposed to a range of art work by artists from many different genres to develop an appreciation for famous works of art in both western and eastern artistic traditions. Pupils will gain an understanding of art history and the development of art over the ages. The curriculum plan contained in this document is aimed at the 9-11 age group covering upper primary.
